

INTOXICATION FROM POISON



Call your vet or poison control center immediately (in some cases, vomiting should be induced, but when certain poisons are ingested, it is not recommended. In general, any product harmful to humans can be harmful to pets as well, such as cleaning products, rodent poisons, antifreeze, and certain food items.) See our rubrics for which foods are toxic to animals.

If your pet's skin is exposed to a toxic product, check the label for instructions on what to do if in contact with skin. It might need to be flushed with water and/or soap.

When giving information about your pet's intoxication, be prepared to give:

- all symptoms
- pet's history
- pet's weight
- a description of the poison (have the packaging available for reference)
- the exposure time and/or quantity ingested
